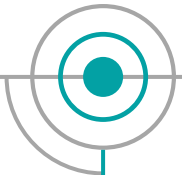

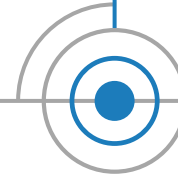

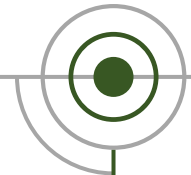
BC Crane Safety collaborates with WorkSafeBC, Yukon WCB, ITA and 52 crane owners, operators and employers on certification system

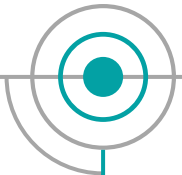


First theoretical and practical Assessments are piloted with 125 participants.

CERTIFICATION PROCESS UNDERWAY



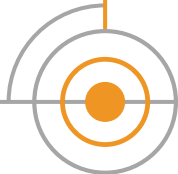

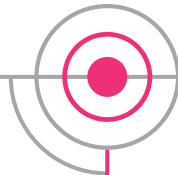
The number of operators certified in the BC and Yukon reaches 500 by April; by September the number rises to 1450.

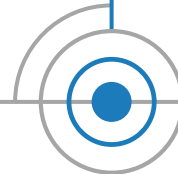

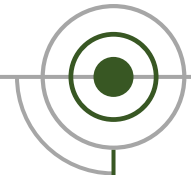
BC Crane Safety strives to meet February deadline to have all operators in BC complete the assessment process.

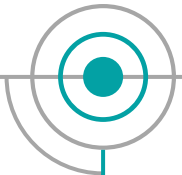


A mutual recognition process with Washington State is piloted for approval the following year

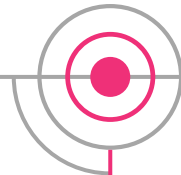
A mutual recognition process with Washington State is established.

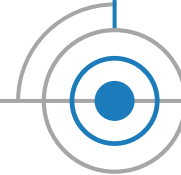

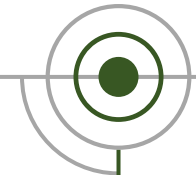
Fed OHSA and US Federal Occupation Safety and Health Administration invite BC Crane Safety to present its certification program.

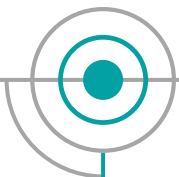


BC Crane Safety is invited to join the expert board of ECOL/ESTA to provide input on an EU-wide standard and certification system.

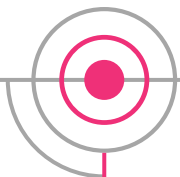
A MOU is signed by ECOL and BC Crane Safety to facilitate mutual recognition of certified mobile crane operators in EU nations
