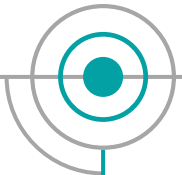

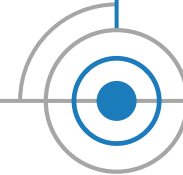

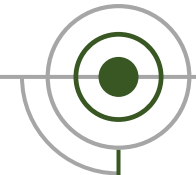
BC Crane Safety collaborates with WSBC, Yukon WCB, ITA and 52 crane owners, operators and employers on certification system.

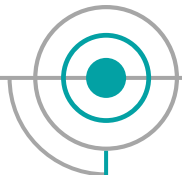


First theoretical and practical Assessments are piloted with 125 participants.

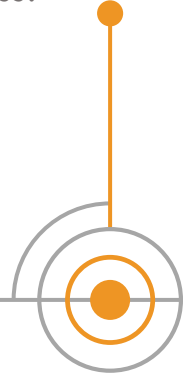

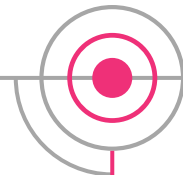
Number of operators in BC and Yukon reaches 500 (April). By September, the number climbs to 1450.

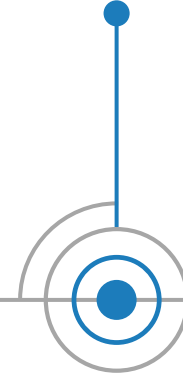

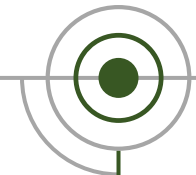
Though BC Crane Safety strives to meet Feb deadline, a high demand outside lower mainland delays completion.

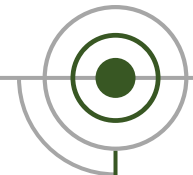
Fed OSHA (US) invites BC Crane Safety to present information on its certification program.

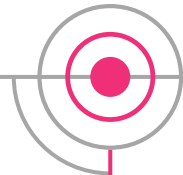

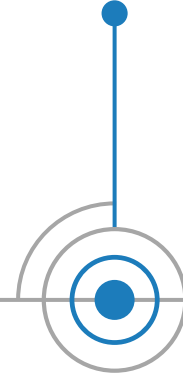

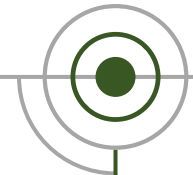
